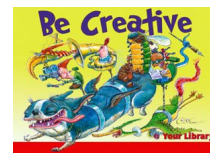
Summer Saturdays

Summer Bookmobile Schedule Begins June 16

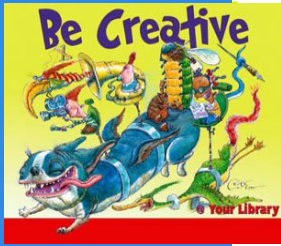

Summer Programs for All Ages

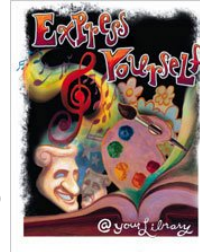
