Tuesday, September 22 at 1 pm will be a game day Tuesday Tue-Do. Join us for an afternoon of cards and good conversation. Adults only please.

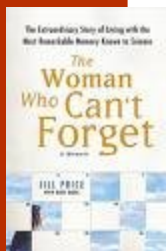
New Fall Bookmobile Schedule
