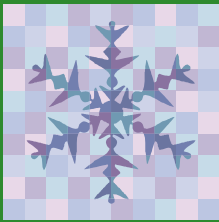
## Holiday Tree Lighting

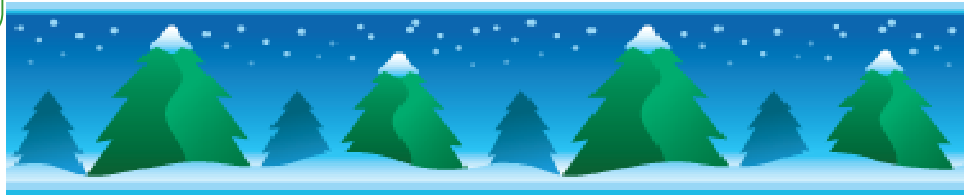
