## BABYTIME LAPSIT PROGRAMS

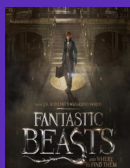
We are updating our popular BabyTime Program! We will now have Toddler Time starting at 10:45 am along with our usual BabyTime beginning at 11:15 am.
