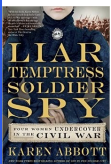

January Book Club

The Kilbourn Public Library Book Club is starting 2017 by reading Karen Abbott's *Liar, Temptress, Soldier, Spy: Four Women Undercover in the Civil War*, which was originally published in September of 2014. Karen Abbott uses a great deal of primary source evidence and personal interviews to tell the tale of four courageous women who were spies during the American Civil War. This book has a local tie as Belle Boyd is one of the women featured in the novel. She used her charm to be an effective spy for the Confederacy, while Emma Edmonds posed as a

man to fight in the Union army, Rose O'Neale Greenhow communicated with Union generals to gather intelligence for the Confederacy and Elizabeth Van Lew was an abolitionist who was able to run an espionage spy ring in the South. It is a spellbinding true story you will truly enjoy. We will discuss this book three times in January.
