Everything I Never Told You by Celeste Ng



Lydia is dead. But they don't know this yet... So begins this novel about a Chinese American family living in 1970s small town Ohio. *Everything I Never Told You* is an exquisite debut novel by Celeste Ng. Lydia is the favorite child of Marilyn and James Lee; their middle daughter, a girl who inherited her mother's bright blue eyes and her father's jet-black hair. Her parents are determined that Lydia will fulfill the dreams they were unable to pursue. But when Lydia's body is found in the local lake, the delicate balancing act that has been keeping the Lee family together tumbles into chaos. This novel is both a gripping page-turner and a sensitive family portrait.
