Everything I Never Told You is an exquisite debut novel by Celeste Ng. Her parents are determined that Lydia will fulfill the dreams they were unable to pursue. But when Lydia's body is found in the local lake, the delicate balancing act that has been keeping the Lee family together tumbles into chaos. This novel is both a gripping page-turner and a sensitive family portrait.
