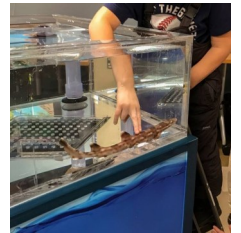
Mascot Day

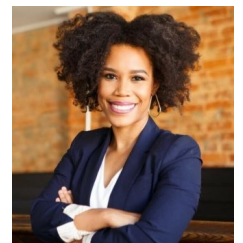
End-of-Summer Reading Finale *Ocean Odyssey* - Friday, August 19 at 2:00 pm
