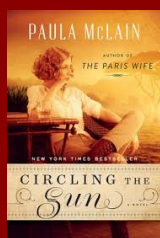
Computer Help - Does the summer heat have you confused on how to use your computer or other electronic device? We can help. **Every Tuesday from 1 to 3:30 pm**.
