Ever wonder about having backyard chickens? Like the idea of having farm fresh eggs from your own flock? Are they really a lot of work?



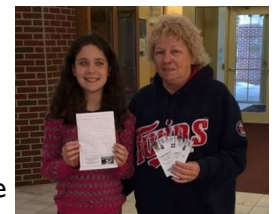

## March Book Discussion

The Kilbourn Public Library will be reading *Furious Hours: Murder, Fraud, and the Last Trial of Harper Lee* by Casey Cep. A true-crime book that delves into a dramatic murder trial in 1970s Alabama, *Furious Hours* goes in depth into the trial, the key participants, and Harper Lee, the writer who spent years of her life after her success with *To Kill a Mockingbird* attempting to write her own true-crime book about the sensational trial. "Furious Hours delivers a gripping, incredibly well-written portrait of not only Harper Lee, but also of mid-20th century Alabama — and a still-unanswered set of crimes to rival the serial killers made infamous in the same time period."
