**STAY SAFE!**

The CDC recommends these steps to keep you and your family safe from COVID-19:

- Wash your hands often (for at least 20 seconds).
- Avoid close contact —stay at home if you can! Keep at least 6 feet of distance from people if you can't stay home.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue or your elbow.
- Wear a cloth face covering if you go out in public
- Clean and disinfect high-touch surfaces daily.
- If you experience any symptoms like a cough, fever, or shortness of breath, stay home (except to get medical care)!

**CURBSIDE PICKUP SERVICE**

We are now offering curbside service! We are excited to serve you again and we are working hard to meet your needs within the restrictions of the Safer at Home order. At this time we are only loaning materials that are at our library—including DVDs, Blu-ray, audiobooks, magazines, puzzles and books.

It's easy to request library materials. You can place your holds for items on LinkCat through our website at [www.dellslibrary.org](http://www.dellslibrary.org). Please make sure the items you are requesting are available on the shelf at the Kilbourn Public Library. When you get a call letting you know your hold is in, give us a call at 608-254-2146 during the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. We will arrange a time for your curbside pickup. Please make sure you have your library card number ready when you call. All curbside pickup must be scheduled ahead of time. If you need assistance placing holds call us or send an email to [staff@dellslibrary.org](mailto:staff@dellslibrary.org). Please let us know title and author information if you would like us to pick out books for you. Let us know if we can make substitutions with similar titles or authors if we can't find exactly what you are looking for.



Items will be picked up in the turnaround in front of the library. Please enter the turnaround from the south and proceed to the stop sign. A staff member will bring out your items in a bag and place them by the book drop. Please allow the staff member time to reenter the building before exiting your car to pick up the items. We want to keep all of our patrons and staff safe.

Items checked out using our curbside service will have standard loan periods. The drop-box will still remain closed. All returned items will be quarantined upon receipt to minimize potential exposure to coronavirus. As a result, don't be surprised if the items you return stay on your account for a few days after you return them. 
