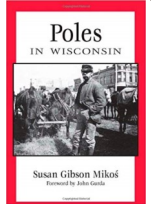

Poles in Wisconsin

On **Tuesday, November 13 at 7 pm** the Dells Country Historical Society will be presenting Susan Mikoś, author of *Poles in Wisconsin*. She will be speaking about the Polish migration to Wisconsin and the culture of the Polish-American people. Susan Mikoś is a historic preservation consultant hailing from Shorewood, Wisconsin. She has been an active participant in several Polish-American organizations such as the Polish Center of Wisconsin, Polanski - the Polish Women's Cultural Club of Milwaukee and also serves as president of The Polish Heritage Alliance/Polish Center of Wisconsin in Franklin, WI. In addition to *Poles in Wisconsin*, Mikoś is the author of *Kresy*, a book of photographs taken by geographer Louise Arner Boyd in the eastern borderlands of Poland in 1934. There will be time included for conversation and discussion following the presentation. Refreshments will be served.
