Tidal Wave of Movies for All Ages on Fridays, June 10 – August 12 at 2 p.m.

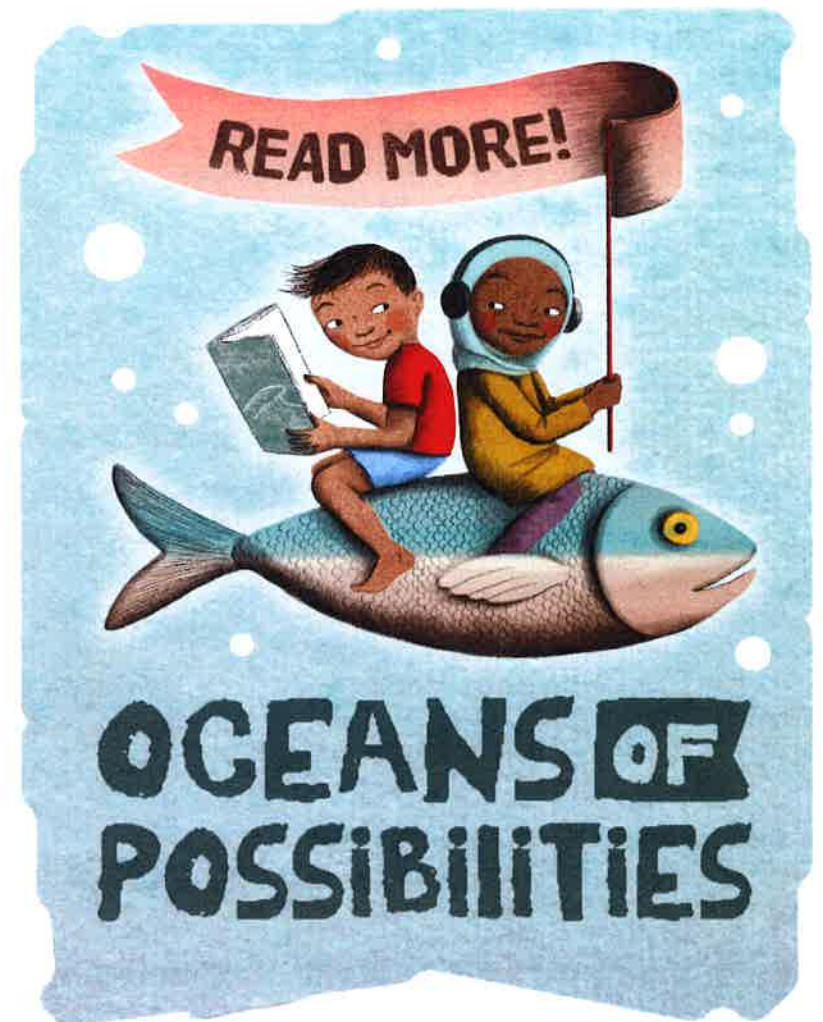
